## **Award Description and Requirements**

- The Exemplary IB Educator Award is offered in recognition of an outstanding educator at your school who has made your school and program great.
- Three awards are offered each academic year, one for each level of the IB program.
- Nominators (principal or coordinator) must attach a word-processed, minimum one-page statement of why you are
  recommending this educator for the CAWS Exemplary IB Educator Award. In your description, please include relevant
  evidence, comments, and testimonials.
- Nominees must submit a completed photo/video release form.
- Each winner will receive a plaque as well as a \$1,000 cash award.
- Awards will be presented at the CAWS Annual Spring Conference. The cost of travel and registration for the conference will be paid by CAWS for each award winner.
- CAWS will consider only one application per school site or IB program.
- Please complete the application in its entirety. Illegible nominations will not be considered.
